### INVESTMENT AND RETURN OBJECTIVE

The Fund is priced in Rands and aims to outperform G7 inflation in Euro terms over time while aiming to limit capital losses.

### INVESTMENT PROCESS

The Fund invests in money market instruments, capital market instruments and equities with an active asset allocation overlay. The equity component of the Fund is always protected. As the underlying Fund is priced in Euro's the exchange rate volatility between Euro's and Rands are reflected in the price. The feeder fund is invested wholly in the Prescient Global Positive Return Fund.

### WHO SHOULD INVEST

Investors seeking a hedge against any Rand depreciation while gaining exposure to a risk aware asset allocation offshore fund. This Fund is suitable to investors with a medium to long-term investment horizon.

### RISK INDICATOR DEFINITION

These portfolios typically exhibit more volatility and potential for capital losses due to higher exposure to equities and exposure to offshore markets where currency fluctuations may result in capital losses. These portfolios typically target returns in the region of 5% - 6% above inflation over the long term.

## FUND COMMENTARY

Global markets sold off in February and nervousness as well as volatility entered markets. As such, the Fund maintained its cautious stance on equities owing to stretched valuations, monetary policy tightening as well as the late stage of the business cycle. Nevertheless, the Fund remained overweight European equity vs US equity, primarily due to the more advanced stage of the US monetary policy tightening cycle. Moreover, nominal interest rates globally have remained low meaning negative real interest rates prevailed. Coupled with this, as Fed are expected to become sellers of treasury bonds from being net buyers for an extended period of time, the Fund persisted with its position of short global interest rate exposure. At the same time, corporate leverage has reach elevated levels around the globe when spreads have been at record low levels. This has resulted in a somewhat circumspect stance taken on credit. Meanwhile, volatility ticked higher, which allowed for a reduction in duration on the hedge position.

**Contributors to performance:** Equities (overweight Europe) and the short interest rates position.

**Detractor from performance:** Cautious positioning in credit.

## GLOSSARY

**Annualised performance:** Annualised performance show longer term performance rescaled to a 1 year period. Annualised performance is the average return per year over the period. Actual annual figures are available to the investor on request.

**Highest & Lowest performance:** The highest and lowest performance for any 1 year over the period since inception have been shown.

**NAV:** The net asset value represents the assets of a Fund less its liabilities.

**Current Yield:** Annual income (interest or dividends) divided by the current price of the security.

**Alpha:** Denoted the outperformance of the fund over the benchmark.

**Sharpe Ratio:** The Sharpe ratio is used to indicate the excess return the portfolio delivers over the risk free rate per unit of risk adopted by the fund.

**Standard Deviation:** The deviation of the return stream relative to its own average.

**Max Drawdown:** The maximum peak to trough loss suffered by the Fund since inception.

**% Positive Month:** The percentage of months since inception where the Fund has delivered positive return.
